This conference has the unique characteristic of building an intellectual bridge between the south and north coasts of the Mediterranean Sea. This year it will be held in Marrakech, an imperial city of Morocco, which was, like this conference, a meeting point between the civilizations of the North and the South.





Microsystems engineering from nano to micro and macro

Andreas G. Andreou, Johns Hopkins U., USA

Circuits and Systems Society's Distinguished Lecturer



Andreas G. Andreou received his Ph.D. in electrical engineering and computer science in 1986 from Johns Hopkins University. Between 1986 and 1989 he held post-doctoral fellow and associate research scientist positions in the Electrical and Computer engineering department while also a member of the professional staff at the Johns Hopkins Applied Physics Laboratory. Andreou became an assistant professor of Electrical and Computer engineering in 1989, associate professor in 1993 and professor in 1996. He is also a professor of Computer Science and of the Whitaker Biomedical Engineering Institute and director of the Institute's Fabrication and Lithography Facility in Clark Hall. He is the co-founder of the Johns Hopkins University Center for Language and Speech Processing. Between 2001 and 2003 he was the founding director of the ABET accredited undergraduate Computer Engineering program. In 1996 and 1997 he was a visiting professor of the computation and neural systems program at the California Institute of Technology. In 1989 and 1991 he was awarded the R.W. Hart Prize for his work on mixed analog/digital integrated circuits for space applications. He is the recipient of the 1995 and 1997 Myril B. Reed Best Paper Award and the 2000 IEEE Circuits and Systems Society, Darlington Best Paper Award. During the summer of 2001 he was a visiting professor in the department of systems engineering and machine intelligence at Tohoku University. In 2006, Prof. Andreou was elected as an IEEE Fellow and a distinguished lecturer of the IEEE EDS society. Andreou's research interests include sensors, micropower electronics, heterogeneous microsystems, and information processing in biological systems. He is a co-editor of the IEEE Press book: Low-Voltage/Low-Power Integrated Circuits and Systems, 1998 (translated in Japanese) and the Kluwer Academic Publishers book: Adaptive Resonance Theory Microchips, 1998. He is an associate editor of IEEE Transactions on Biomedical Circuits and Systems.

New Design Paradigms: New Architectures for New technologies

Giovanni De Micheli, EPF Lausanne, Switzerland



Giovanni De Micheli is Professor and Director of the Integrated Systems Centre at EPF Lausanne, Switzerland, and President of the Scientific Committee of CSEM, Neuchatel, Switzerland. Previously, he was Professor of Electrical Engineering at Stanford University. He holds a Nuclear Engineer degree (Politecnico di Milano, 1979), a M.S. and a Ph.D. degree in Electrical Engineering and Computer Science (University of California at Berkeley, 1980 and 1983). His research interests include several aspects of design technologies for integrated circuits and systems, such as synthesis, hw/sw codesign and low-power design, as well as systems on heterogeneous platforms including electrical, optical, micromechanical and biological components. He is author of: *Synthesis and Optimization of Digital Circuits*, McGraw-Hill, 1994, co-author and/or co-editor of six other books and of over 300 technical articles. He is, or has been, member of the technical advisory board of several companies, including Magma Design Automation, Certess, Coware and STMicroelectronics.

Prof. De Micheli is the recipient of the 2003 IEEE Emanuel Piore Award for contributions to computer-aided synthesis of digital systems. He is a Fellow of ACM and IEEE. He received the Golden Jubilee Medal for outstanding contributions to the IEEE CAS Society in 2000. He received the 1987 D. Pederson Award for the best paper on the IEEE Transactions on CAD/ICAS, two Best Paper Awards at the Design Automation Conference, in 1983 and in 1993, and a Best Paper Award at the DATE Conference in 2005.

He has been serving IEEE in several capacities, namely: Division 1 Director (2008-9), co-founder and President Elect of the IEEE Council on EDA (2005-7), President of the IEEE CAS Society (2003), Editor in Chief of the IEEE Transactions on CAD/ICAS (1987-2001). He was Program Chair of the pHealth and VLSI SOC conferences in 2006. He was the Program and General Chair of the Design Automation Conference (DAC) in 1996-1997 and 2000 respectively. He was the Program and General Chair of the International Conference on Computer Design (ICCD) in 1988 and 1989 respectively. He served also as editor or guest editor of numerous international journals.

Obaidat has served as distinguished speaker/visitor of IEEE Computer Society, ACM and SCS distinguished Lecturer. He served as the Scientific Advisor for the World Bank/UN Digital Inclusion Workshop. He was member of the board of directors of the Society for Computer Simulation International. He served as Vice President of Conferences of the Society for Modeling and Simulation International SCS and as SCS Vice President of Membership. Currently, He is the Senior Vice President of SCS. His research interests are: wireless communications and networks, telecommunications and Networking systems, security of network, information and computer systems, security of e-based systems, performance evaluation of computer systems, algorithms and networks, high performance and parallel computing/computers, applied neural networks and pattern recognition, adaptive learning and speech processing.

Recently, Prof. Obaidat has been awarded a Nokia Research Fellowship and the distinguished Fulbright Scholar Award. Prof. Obaidat is a Fellow of the Society for Modeling and Simulation International SCSI, and a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE).

Trends in complex SoC Design: From technology variability to multiprocessor architectures

Didier Lattard, CEA-LETI, France



Didier Lattard was born in Saint Marcellin, France, in 1963. He received his Ph.D. degree in Microelectronics from the National Polytechnic Institute of Grenoble, France, in 1989.

In 1990, he joined the CEA-LETI laboratory in the Center for Innovation in micro & nanotechnology (MINATEC), Grenoble. He was involved in the design of image and baseband processing circuits as senior R&D engineer and project leader. From 2003 to 2006, he led the development of the FAUST NoC-based telecom platform. Since 2006, he has been in charge of new projects in imaging and high-performance computing applications. He has published 29 papers in books, refereed journals and conferences. He holds 17 patents in the fields of baseband processing and NoC architectures.

Low-Voltage Limitations and Challenges of Memory-Rich Nano-Scale CMOS LSIs

Kiyoo Itoh, Hitachi, Japan



KIYOO ITOH received the B.S. and Ph.D. Degrees in Electrical Engineering from Tohoku University, Japan, in 1963 and 1976. He is currently a Hitachi Fellow. He was a Visiting MacKay Lecturer at U.C. Berkeley, a Visiting Professor at the U of Waterloo, and a Consulting Professor at Stanford U. He was a Member of the IEEE Fellow Committee, and an elected AdCom Member of IEEE Solid-State Circuits Society. He is a Distinguished Lecturer of the IEEE Solid-state Circuits Society. Since 1972 he has led RAM circuit technology at Hitachi Ltd: He was the lead designer of the first prototype for eight generations of Hitachi DRAMs ranging from 4Kb to 64Mb. In the course of the developments he invented in 1974 the concept of folded data-line architecture, which uses a pair of balanced data lines to eliminate various noise components, and presented the architecture for a 64-Kb DRAM at the 1980 ISSCC. Since that time, this architecture has been adopted for nearly all DRAM chips since produced. He went on to develop key DRAM devices, circuits, and architectures such as the triple-well structure, on-chip voltage down-converters enabling the aging (burn-in) stress test, and low-power high-speed PMOS word driver and multi-divided data-line architecture. As early as 1988, he initiated circuit inventions and developments to reduce subthreshold current of MOSFETs even for the active mode, which is highlighted today in low-voltage CMOS LSI design. Typical examples of the reduction circuits are multi-threshold (V_t) CMOS logic, various gate-source (self) back-biasing schemes, and power switch that we take for granted today. He holds over 420 patents in Japan and US. He authored four books and three book chapters on memory designs, and contributed over 130 technical papers and presentations. Dr. Itoh has won many honors: IEEE Paul Rappaport Award, the Best Paper Award of ESSCIRC90, IEEE Solid-State Circuits Award, and IEEE Jun-ichi Nishizawa Medal. He is an IEEE Fellow. In Japan, his awards include the National Invention Award (Prize of the Patent Attorney's Association of Japan) in 1989, the Commendation by the Minister of State for Science and Technology (Person of Scientific and Technological Merits) in 1997, and the National Medal of Honor with Purple Ribbon in 2000.
