

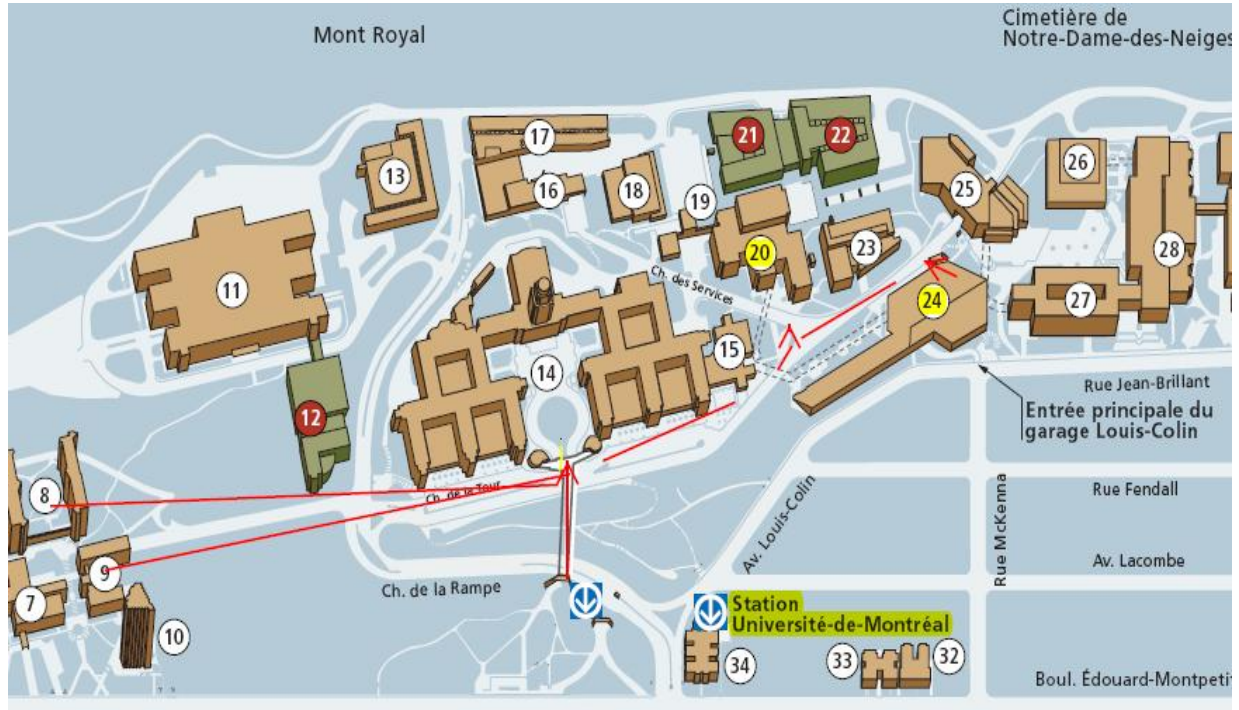

By car

- If you are **driving** please consult the map for the entrance to the **parking garage Louis-Colin @ \$12 per day** (*building 24 on the map*). Follow the red line from the top floor of the garage to **André-Aisenstadt**.

By public transit

- If you are taking **public transit**, the best way to access the university is by metro in the public transit system of the STM.

Be sure to consult the STM website in advance to determine what kind of ticket suits your needs for the whole time of the conference. There will be multiple occasions to take public transit from the conference venue to the evening events.

The metro stop is **Université de Montréal** on the **Ligne Bleu** (*building #34 on the campus map*)

To reach André-Aisenstadt, which is higher up the mountain, you must, on leaving the train and going towards the exit:

- **follow** the signs for the “**Université de Montréal**”
 - **turn left** in front of the **small store** inside the station
 - **go out** of the building and **re-enter** another immediately on the **right**
 - take the moving staircase to the **upper level** - see the red arrow on the map
 - **exit** the building and turn to the **left** so you are walking along the road toward the **south** - as indicated by the red line on the map.
- If you are arriving from **Les Studios Hôtel** (*the university residences*) you can walk along the **Chemin de la Tour** (see red lines on map).
